ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued, constituting a high level committee, for Fisheries Department for the tender value which exceeds Rs.1.00 Crore. In the above Government Order, the Government also ratified the action of the Director of Fisheries for having formed the Tender Award Committee for works costing below Rs.1.00 Crore.

2. In the G.O second read above, the Government issued another Order in supersession of the orders issued in the G.O first read above forming a separate Tender Award Committee for the execution of works in Fisheries Department. One for the works costing less than Rs. 30.00 lakhs and another for works costing more than Rs. 30.00 lakhs.

3. The Committee mentioned in the G.O second read above could not serve the purpose of the Fisheries Department as it involves long process. Since the Superintending Engineer, has already been conferred with the technical powers of Chief Engineer (PWD) at the time of formation of Fishing Harbour Circle vide G.O (Ms) No.37, F & F dated 12.1.1993, it is considered

necessary to restore the Committee constituted in G.O (Ms) No. 62, Animal Husbandry and Fisheries Department, dated 15.9.2003 to speed up the construction works of Fishing Harbour Circle.

4. The Director of Fisheries who was requested to examine the above issue and send proposal to Government. He has suggested that Director of Fisheries may be included as Chairman of the High Level Committee for the Tender value costing more than Rs. 1.00 Crore as the Director has not been included as a member of the Committee in the Government Order first read above. The Finance Department may be represented by an Officer in the cadre of Joint Secretary instead of Additional Secretary. As far as the Tender Award Committee for works costing less than Rs.1.00 Crore is concerned, the Accounts Officer working in the Office of the Director of Fisheries may be appointed as a member of the Tender Award Committee to take care of financial aspects.

5. The Government have examined the proposal of Director of Fisheries and decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government in supersession of the Orders issued in the G.O second read above, direct that the two Tender Award Committee with the following Officials be formed.
