In the Circular memorandum under reference first cited, it  
has been instructed to constitute a Tender Scrutiny Committee at  
Division level and at Circle level as stated below:

Works up to Rs.6 lakhs (at Division level).	1. Executive Engineer. 2. Senior Draughting Officer. 3. Divisional Accountant.
Works up to Rs.30 lakhs (at Circle level).	1. Superintending Engineer, 2. Deputy Superintending Engineer. 3. Head Draughting Officer/A.E.O. of the Circle.

Subsequently the Tamilnadu Transparency in Tender Act has come  
in force with effect from the 1st October 2000 as ordered in the  
Circular cited. As per the rule 30 (1) of chapter VI of Tender Act,  
the Tender Scrutiny Committee shall prepare a detailed evaluation  
report which shall be considered by the Tender accepting authority  
before taking a final decision on the tender. From this, it is  
obvious that the tender Scrutiny Committee and Tender accepting  
authority should not have the same members. This subject was  
discussed in the Board of Engineers meeting for their comments.  
The Board of Engineers after detailed discussion in its 413th  
meeting on 27.7.2001 has resolved that the Tender accepting authority  
should be kept out of the Tender Scrutiny Committee and the Tender  
Scrutiny Committee may be reconstituted considering the above said  
as stated below:

of the Circle office.
3. head Draughting Officer/Senior D.O. of  
the Circle.

In view of the above reference it is instructed that in partial modification of the circular already issued vide this office reference first cited, the Tender Scrutiny Committee is now reconstituted as resolved in the Board of Engineers meeting. The Superintending Engineers/Executive Engineers are requested to adhere to the revised circular and reconstitute the Tender Scrutiny Committee suitably.
