



ABSTRACT

Disposal of unserviceable earth moving equipments, obsolete non moving surplus spares of machinery, scarp materials, old obsolete machinery of Public Works Workshop, unusable old vehicles and old spare parts of Public Works Workshop – Constitution of a Technical Committee – Orders – Issued.

From the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department, Chennai-5, Letter No.S7(1) / 54962/98, dated 22.12.2011.

ORDER :

In the reference read above, the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department, has stated that at present in the Water Resources Department, large number of unserviceable machinery / vehicles / obsolete spares of various machinery are available for condemnation. These machinery which are kept idle at various project sites and departmental store yards, having served more than the normal life period, have to be disposed off. If these machinery and other items are dumped in the store yard for longer duration, due to change in a temperature, the machinery and their parts will get rusted and the value of the materials will become less, thus leading to loss of revenue to Government. Further, to safeguard and maintain the unserviceable items, huge Government money is spent every year.

2) The Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department has therefore, proposed to constitute a Single Technical Committee consisting of the following members to valuate unserviceable item :-

- 1 Chief Engineer, Operation & Maintenance, Chennai
- 2 Superintending Engineer, Workshop Circle, Chennai.
- 3 Director, Institute of Hydraulics and Hydrology, Poondi.

4. General Superintendent, Workshop and Stores
5. Superintending Engineer incharge of surplus unserviceable items.
6. Assistant Executive Engineer, Procurement and Stores Sub-Division, Chennai.

3) The Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department has further stated that the following items will be valued by the Technical Committee :-

- 1) Unserviceable earth moving equipments such as Road Roller, Bull Dozer, Rigs, Levelers, Scrapper, Excavator, Dumpers, Cranes, Front Compressor etc.
- 2) Obsolete non moving surplus spares of machinery.
- 3) Scrap materials, such as mould box, base plates, etc.
- 4) Old obsolete Machinery including Sheds and other Stores, M.S. Scrap and ferrous turnings lying waste in the Workshop.
- 5) Unusable old vehicles and old spare parts available in Public Works Department Workshop and Stores.

The Technical Committee will inspect and assess the value of each item, taking into account, the present condition of the machinery and assess their present market value. Based on the Technical Committee's report, necessary proposal shall be prepared and sent to the Government, if the power for accepting the valuation report exceeds the power of the department officers.

4) The Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department, has therefore, requested to constitute a Technical Committee to assess the value of the unserviceable earth moving equipments, obsolete non-moving surplus spares of machinery, scarp materials, old obsolete machinery of Public Works Workshop, unusable old vehicles and old spare parts of Public Works Workshop in order to finalise the disposable materials without further loss of revenue to the Government.

5) The Government after examination of the proposal of the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Department, has decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government issue the following orders :-

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i) A Single Technical Committee consisting of the following members is constituted to value the unserviceable items in the Water Resources Department :-

- 1 Chief Engineer, Operation & Maintenance, Chennai
- 2 Superintending Engineer, Workshop Circle, Chennai.
- 3 Director, Institute of Hydraulics and Hydrology, Poondi.
- 4 General Superintendent, Workshop and Stores.
- 5 Superintending Engineer incharge of surplus unserviceable items
- 6 Assistant Executive Engineer, Procurement and Stores Sub-Division, Chennai.

ii) The Technical Committee constituted in para 5 (i) above shall value the following unserviceable items :-

- 1) Unserviceable earth moving equipments such as Road Roller, Bull Dozer, Rigs, Levelers, Scrapper, Excavator, Dumpers Cranes, Front Compressor etc.
- 2) Obsolete non moving surplus spares of machinery
- 3) Scrap materials, such as mould box, base plates, etc.
- 4) Old obsolete Machinery including Sheds and other Stores, M.S. Scrap and ferrous turnings lying waste in the Workshop.
- 5) Unusable old vehicles and old spare parts available in Public Works Department Workshop and Stores.

iii) The Technical Committee shall inspect and assess the value of each item, taking into account the present condition of the machinery and assess their present market value. Based on the Technical Committee's report, necessary proposal shall be sent to the Government for approval if the power for accepting the valuation report exceeds the power of the department officers as per Public Works Department Code.


