Ex-Servicemen's Welfare - Constructions relating to the Department of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare - Payment of centage charges to Public Works Department - 100% Exemption from payment of centage charges to Public Works Department in respect of all Construction Works relating to the Department of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare - Granted - General Orders - Issued.

ORDER :

In the G.O. first read above the Government have ordered that the Director of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare be exempted from payment of centage charges to Public Works Department towards all construction works relating to the Department of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare in general upto an extent of 50% of the said charges. Separate orders for 50% exemption from payment of centage charges to Public Works Department for undivided construction is not necessary.

2. In the letter second read above the Director of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare has stated that, the buildings of Department of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare likes Jawans Bhavan, Jawans Market, and Ex-Services Centre are being constructed out of Tamil Nadu Ex-Services Personnel Benevolent Fund by Public Works Department after getting administrative approval from the Government of Tamil Nadu. The above said Benevolent Fund is constituted out of the Flag Day Collection received from public every year. The income derived by way of licence fee (rent) from these buildings which were let out to offices and commercial establishments is also credited to the Benevolent Fund. This Fund is utilized for implementation of

various welfare schemes for the welfare and resettlement of Ex-Servicemen and their dependents and also to the bereaved family of martyrs. The periodic maintenance and repairs of these buildings also take considerable portion of this income.

3. The Director of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare has also stated that many new Schemes have been implemented towards welfare of Ex-Servicemen and their dependents and the quantum of financial assistance to Ex-Services population who are in distress for various diseases / reasons and scholarship to wards of Ex-Servicemen have also been considerably enhanced, out of Tamil Nadu Ex-Services Personnel Benevolent Fund, resulting in sizeable, amount of financial out flow. The Director of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare has therefore, requested the Government to grant cent percent exemption from payment of centage charges towards all construction proposals of the Directorate.

4. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal, direct that the Director of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare be granted cent percent exemption from payment of centage charges to Public Works Department towards all construction works relating to the Department of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare.

5. This order issues with the concurrence of Public Works and Finance Departments vide their U.O. Nos. 3446/G2/2018-1, dated 05.03.2018 and 12022/Fin (Pub)/2018, dated 11 .07.2018 respectively.
