ABSTRACT.

Buildings—Levy of centage charges by Public Works Department and Highways and Rural Works Department—R orders issued.

(G.O. Ms. No. 423, Public Works, dated 13th March 1978)

READ AGAIN :—

From the Chief Engineer (Buildings), P.W.D. Lr. No. II (2)/CHD/78, dated 28th September 1979.

ORDER :

At present different agencies of Government levy centage charges at different rates in respect of the works executed by them on behalf of other Departments, etc. This has led to a certain amount of unhealthy competition among the various agencies in securing work from other Departments, etc. The Public Works Department and Highways and Rural Works Department levy centage charges at 15 per cent of the estimate of works while the Tamil Nadu Housing Board and the Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board levy centage charges at 12 per cent of the estimates. The Government have, in consultation with the Board of Chief Engineers, decided to reduce from April 1980, the rate of centage charges from 15 per cent to 12 per cent.

12½ per cent as follows, of the estimates of works executed by the Public Works Department and Highways and Rural Works Department subject to review once in five years :—

(i) Establishment	10 per cent.
(ii) Audit and Accounts	1 per cent.
(iii) Pensionary charges	1½ per cent.
Total	12½ per cent.

2. The centage charges levied for the works executed on behalf of the Government of India will remain as 19 per cent without any change.

3. This order issues with the concurrence of the Transport and Finance Departments—vide their U.O. No. 75962|R1|79-1, dated 31st December 1979 and 3077|PW|80-1, dated 18th January 1980 respectively.
